

COVID-19 coronavirus

Transperth School Services – Term 2



Following the Government's announcement to reopen schools from the beginning of Term 2, Transperth will be changing its current service provision to better meet any resulting increase in patronage.

Please note that while we are asking passengers to maintain as much space as possible between themselves and others on our services, given our finite number of buses, trains and ferries, we cannot guarantee that social distancing guidelines can be met, especially as patronage grows. This is particularly true during peak periods and on school services.

We continue to ask all passengers to follow the recommended personal hygiene regime and not use public transport if they are sick.

From Wednesday 29 April Transperth services will upgrade as follows:

Buses

- Normal pre COVID-19 weekday timetable, including school specials and services that deviate via schools

Trains

Wednesday 29 April – Sunday 3 May:

- Services from Monday to Friday will operate on an enhanced Saturday timetable, with additional peak period services and earlier services on most lines.

From Monday 4 May:

- Services will operate the normal pre COVID-19 weekday, Saturday and Sunday/Public Holiday timetable.

CAT Buses (Perth, Joondalup and Fremantle)

- Will operate on a normal pre COVID-19 weekday, Saturday and Sunday/Public Holiday timetable.

Ferry

- Ferry services will continue to operate on a Winter timetable.
