Our nationally accredited Bachelor of Education (Secondary) is introducing two new majors in 2021:

- Chemistry Education Major
- Physics Education Major

These majors, available on our Joondalup campus, have been designed to equip students with the skills and knowledge to teach Years 7 to 12 Chemistry and/or Physics and provides the extended content knowledge needed to address the demands and opportunities of the secondary school chemistry and physics curriculum.

For students interested in the Chemistry Education Major it is desirable that all applicants have ATAR Chemistry.

All applicants for the Physics Education Major are required to demonstrate satisfactory performance in Physics ATAR, with equivalents considered.
