Parking and Student Drop Off

I am still very concerned about student drop off and pick up by parents on Amelia Street. I have been at the front of the school at the end of the school day and am horrified at driver behaviour, such as:

- Stopping on crest of hill to pick up students.
- Driving slowly while on mobile phone.
- Stopping in the middle of the road.
- U turns in front of oncoming traffic.
- Entering school grounds to pick up students.

Please note: there is NO capacity to park and collect students from the staff carpark.

Poincaire Street is available to pick up and drop off your child. Students are able to access through designated safe walkways. I strongly encourage you to instruct your child to use Poincaire Street. If using Amelia Street, ask them to walk to you at the bottom of Amelia Street - do not stop in front of the school to pick up or drop off your child.
