Year 11 Course Overview

Dimensional Design may include elements of architecture, fine homeware, and furniture design. This course enables students to understand the design process and how it is used to develop and create objects that have three dimensional content through various design processes, along with practical skills and practices.

Year 11 Structure

Unit 1 – Design fundamentals

The focus of this unit is to introduce design process and practice. Students learn that design process can be used to provide solutions to design problems through design conception, development, production and evaluation. Students are introduced to these concepts through manual and technology based methods for design, along with workshop based practical skills and processes.

Unit 2 – Personal design

The focus of this unit is developing a personal design piece. Students further develop their understanding of the design process through creating a single design piece that visually communicate aspects of their personality, values and beliefs. Through design conception and development, students refine their ideas then create their final piece using their understanding and skills learnt in Unit 1.
