NAPLAN

Every year students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 participate in NAPLAN tests in reading, writing, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. The assessment provides parents and schools with an understanding of how individual students are performing at the time of the tests. NAPLAN is just one aspect of a school's assessment and reporting process. It does not replace ongoing assessments made by teachers. All Year 7 and Year 9 students will be provided with a detailed NAPLAN testing commences from Friday 3 March until Monday 27 March 2023.

Balcatta Bullets Running Club

VaccinateWA - School-Based Immunisation Program

The School-Based Immunisation Program (SBIP) is a wellestablished service which offers National Immunisation Program immunisations to students in Years 7 and 10.

The VaccinateWA system is to be used by parents/carers to complete the vaccination consent form in order for their children/dependants to receive vaccinations whilst at school. (Please Note: VaccinateWA is not being used to book appointments for the School-Based Immunisation Program).

To provide consent for vaccination, the first step is to register your child/dependant on VaccinateWA. Log into your <u>VaccinateWA</u> account and follow the steps to "Add or manage dependants". If you do not have a VaccinateWA account, you will need to create one for yourself first.

Immunisation Dates:

Year 7 Round 2 (HPV Dose 2) – Monday 28 August Year 10 (Meningococcal ACWY) – Friday 21 July

If you are unable to complete the online consent form, the school will have forms available for you to use. If the information you provide needs to be clarified, you may be contacted by a staff member from the vaccination team.

If you have already completed and returned a paper consent form, the SBIP team is currently uploading the information into the VaccinateWA system. This process may take several weeks, and you will receive an email confirmation once it has been completed.

Student Mobile Phone Reminder

As you are aware, the State Government implemented a Student Mobile Phones in Public Schools policy. The policy requires all public schools to implement a ban on the use of mobile phones, smart watches, earbuds, tablets and headphones for all students from the time they arrive at school to the end of the school day. The policy is 'off and away all day'. Exceptions are allowed for students who have approval from the Principal to use a phone to monitor health conditions or when a teacher gives students permission to use mobile phones for a specific curriculum purpose. If a student needs to contact a parent/guardian, they can ask at Student Services. Parents **must always** communicate through the school on 9345 8200 if they need to make emergency contact with their child/ren.

Attendance Process

All students are expected to attend every school day and to be on time. Students who arrive late to school may miss information at the start of the lesson. Arrivals after 8.50am are classified as a morning absence and require students to bring a note from their parent/guardian explaining their absence.

Leaving School Early

No student is permitted to leave the school grounds without permission from their parent/guardian. Parents requiring permission for their child to leave the school grounds **must** provide the student with a note and contact Student Services either via SMS on 0409 686 684 or via email at balcatta.shs@education.wa.edu.au. Students must sign out at Student Services, allowing them to leave the school grounds. Parents **must not contact** their child direct. Communications must be made through Student Services.
