#### Year 10 students going into Year 11, 2024

The interview process for students to select their courses for Year 11 in 2024 will continue next term from Tuesday 18 July to Friday 28 July Parents will be able to access <u>SOBS</u> to make appointments (25 mins timeslots) with either Tessa Curtis, Claire Piesse or Joh Gatti. ## VaccinateWA – School-Based Immunisation Program

The School-Based Immunisation Program (SBIP) is a wellestablished service which offers the National Immunisation Program immunisations to students in Years 7 and 10.

The VaccinateWA system enables parents/carers to give consent for their children/dependants to receive vaccinations whilst at school. (Please note: VaccinateWA is not being used to book appointments for the School-Based Immunisation Program).

To provide consent for vaccination, the first step is to register your child/dependant on VaccinateWA. Log into your VaccinateWA account and follow the steps to "Add or manage dependants". If you do not have a VaccinateWA account, you will need to create one for yourself first.

If you are unable to register online, download the <u>Consent Form</u>. If you have problems downloading the Consent Form, spare hard copies are available from the Admin office. The Consent Form is to be completed, signed then returned to the Admin office as soon as possible in Week 1 next term.

Step by step information for using VaccinateWA is available on the <a href="HealthyWA">HealthyWA</a> website. Please call 13 26843 if you have any technical issues.

Year 10 students are scheduled to receive their vaccinations on Friday 21 July (Term 3, Week 1). No vaccinations will be given to students unless you have provided prior consent.

## **Learning Area News**

#### **Excursion to Herdsmans Lake**

On Friday 23 June and Monday 26 June, Year 9 Science students had the opportunity to participate in a science excursion to Herdsmans Lake Discovery Centre and to participate in a series of hands-on workshops run by the centre. Students learnt about the ecological community of interdependent organisms in an aquatic ecosystem.

Students discovered the aquatic, bird, animal and plant life which live in and around Herdsmans Lake. The day started with a quick lesson on food webs and energy flow, which related directly to Herdsman Lake's ecosystem, to create a common understanding as well as the following activities:

Biotic sampling - students were outside using scoop nets to sample macro invertebrates. They were asked to identify, sort and classify their catches, before putting them back in the lake.

Abiotic Study - students tested sites at the lake and drain for pH, turbidity, temperature and salinity (electrical conductivity).

Biotic Study – students went for a walk to explore the diversity of birds and other creatures around the lake and developed an overall snapshot of the quality of the lake at that particular time.

The day ended in the Wildlife Centre where students explored their displays of work.
