Brazil Scholarship Opportunity and Homestay

We have an exciting opportunity to potentially participate in a great program for our school. As part of a proposed scholarship program, the Brazilian Government is sponsoring 100 students from Brazil to spend one semester studying in a public high school in Western Australia. The students will undertake their studies in Term 1 and Term 2 of 2024 (a period of 23 weeks). The students are aged between 15-17 years and will enrol in Year 10 or Year 11.

We have the opportunity to enrol a number of these students in our school. However we need families to host and provide accommodation for them. Families will receive full support from the Australian Homestay Network to host students. Each student will need their own room in the home of a host family.

Please note this is only the first step in the process. There is other work being undertaken by the Department of Education on the promotion to families of this initiative.

Saver Plus

School camps are an amazing opportunity for your children. However they can be stressful for some parents to afford.

If you have children attending camps in 2024, <u>Saver Plus</u> will assist with saving and budgeting for the camp.

Saver Plus encourages parents to save \$50 a month (for 10 months). The savings is then matched - a free \$500 for education costs, making \$1,000 available for the school camp.

Families who start saving in September will have their savings ready to pay their school camp fees in July 2024.

Saver Plus will chat with families about eligibility:

- Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card
- · Payment from Centrelink and
- Earning an income (employment, carer's payment, or child support).
