From the Principal

Just a reminder to all parents and guardians regarding the following processes:

Attendance Process – All students are expected to attend every school day and to be on time. Students who arrive late to school may miss information at the start of the lesson. Arrivals after 8.50am are classified as a morning absence and require students to bring a note from their parent/guardian explaining their absence.

Leaving School Early – No student is permitted to leave the school grounds without permission from their parent/guardian. Parents requiring permission for their child to leave the school grounds **must** provide the student with a note and contact Student Services either via SMS on 0409 686 684 or via email at balcatta.shs@education.wa.edu.au. Students must sign out at Student Services allowing them to leave the school grounds.

Learning Area News

Year 10 Childcare

Students in Year 10 Childcare have been studying play-based activities. They have looked at different types of play and the reasons why children engage in play. They have also researched different developmental levels and looked at how different activities and toys support development at various age ranges from 0-5 age groups. They have researched different types of toys and taken into consideration design features, safety aspects and looked at how they encourage different types of play. Finally their assessment involved designing a playground for a range of ages. Students put in an enormous amount of effort into their projects.

Accredited Course in Early Career Discovery

On Friday 10 November, the last cohort of Year 9 students engaged in a rewarding experience at the Northbridge TAFE campus. Participating in hands-on activities, students were given the choice to delve into either jewellery-making or a fitness-based career taster, providing a first-hand look into potential vocational paths.

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In addition to these activities, students successfully concluded their assessments for the Course in Early Career Discovery. This accredited qualification is designed to expose students to a range of career possibilities early on, aiding them in making well-informed decisions about their educational journey beyond Year 10.

The initiative, aimed at empowering students to shape their academic and post-secondary choices, demonstrated considerable success. Our students thoroughly enjoyed exploring the TAFE campus and gaining valuable insights into diverse courses and pathways available for their future pursuits.

This enriching experience not only broadened their horizons but also provided them with concrete insights into potential career paths and further training opportunities available at TAFE.

Free Swimming Instructor Course for students

The Department of Education has a free Swimming Instructor course for students in Balga on **Sunday 19 November 2023**.

Students will:

- obtain an accredited Swimming Instructor and CPR qualification for free.
- gain paid employment teaching VacSwim and Interm swimming lessons.

Who Can register?

Students who are at least 17 years of age.

Students do not require a minimum level of swimming to be eligible for the course, however, they must be confident in the water.

Student transition to employment with the Department of Education

The Department will support students to transition to employment for VacSwim and Interm swimming programs through:

· ongoing support and mentoring

 covering the costs of relevant screening including Working with Children Check and Department of Education Nationally Coordinated Criminal History Check.

Students will be able to apply for swimming instructor positions across the State.

Brazil Scholarship Opportunity and Homestay

We have an exciting opportunity to participate in a great program for our school. As part of a proposed scholarship program, the Brazilian Government is sponsoring 100 students from Brazil to spend one semester studying in a public high school in Western Australia. The students will undertake their studies in Term 1 and Term 2 of 2024 (a period of 23 weeks). The students are aged between 15-17 years and will enrol in Year 10 or Year 11.

We have the opportunity to enrol a number of these students in our school, however we need families to host and provide accommodation for them. Families will receive full support from the Australian Homestay Network to host students. Each student will need their own room in the home of a host family.
