On Friday 26 April we held our formal ANZAC Commemoration Service. Our local Member for Balcatta Mr David Michael MLA and Major David Harbison of the Australian Army were able to join us. The Student Councillors led the service which included reflection of the importance of Gallipoli and acknowledging the role of Australia in peace-keeping missions, specifically East Timor. This year marked the 25th anniversary of Australia's involvement to help East Timor gain independence.

The service included poem readings of "For the Fallen" and "In Flanders Fields" and the laying of the wreath by Mr Michael and Major Harbison.

NAP Opt-In 2024 Assessment in Science Literacy

On Tuesday 21 May, Year 10 Science students will participate in the NAP Opt-In Assessment in Science Literacy provided by the Australian Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA) direct to schools nation-wide. The assessment will provide the school with information on Year 10 students' performance in relation to national standards in Science Literacy. We will be provided with reports looking at school and student performance which can be used to inform teaching and learning.

Year 8 to Year 9 students going into Year 9 and Year 10 in 2025

During Week 4, Year 8 and Year 9 students will be attending 2025 course selection presentations where they will be informed of the course selection process for the different learning areas.

Students will be given a personalised course selection form which needs to be completed and signed by you as parent/guardian and returned to the administration office in Amelia Street as soon as possible, with the latest date being Friday 7 June 2024.

Parents will be able to access <u>SOBS</u> from **9.00am Monday 17 June** to make appointments (25 mins timeslots) with either Tessa Curtis, Dimi Martino, Jane Balcombe or Miles Attey. **Students must bring their personalised Year 11 Course Selection form to the meeting.**

WA Student Assistance Payment

The State Government announced the <u>WA Student Assistance Payment</u> which is an initiative offering a cost-of-living payment for every student in Western Australia to provide financial relief and assist families with their children's schooling.

Click on this <u>link</u> to make a claim. <u>PARENTS ONLY</u> (as claimant) are to submit the claim. To be eligible for the payment, parents will require a valid WA Student Number (WASN). This 8-digit number can be found on Student SmartRider cards, school reports (including NAPLAN, Interim Reports, Semester Reports and your child's Contributions and Charges (fees) statements.

Saver Plus

<u>Saver Plus</u> is a FREE 10-month matched savings and financial education program funded by ANZ and the Australian Government Department of Social Services and delivered by The Smith Family. The program aims to help participants to learn how to better manage their money and develop long-term savings habits.

Saver Plus is available to anyone who is eligible across Australia.

Eligible participants learn money skills and receive up to \$500 to help with their school expenses.

- 10-month program (commence at any time)
- Save \$50 a month for 10 months and receive \$500 towards educational costs

 Complete up to 10 hours of Virtual workshops called MoneyMinded (support provided)

If you save \$50 a month for 10 months, ANZ will double it. The money helps you with school costs. Income, eligibility and participation criteria apply. More information at www.saverplus.org.au.
