Parent Owned Device (POD)

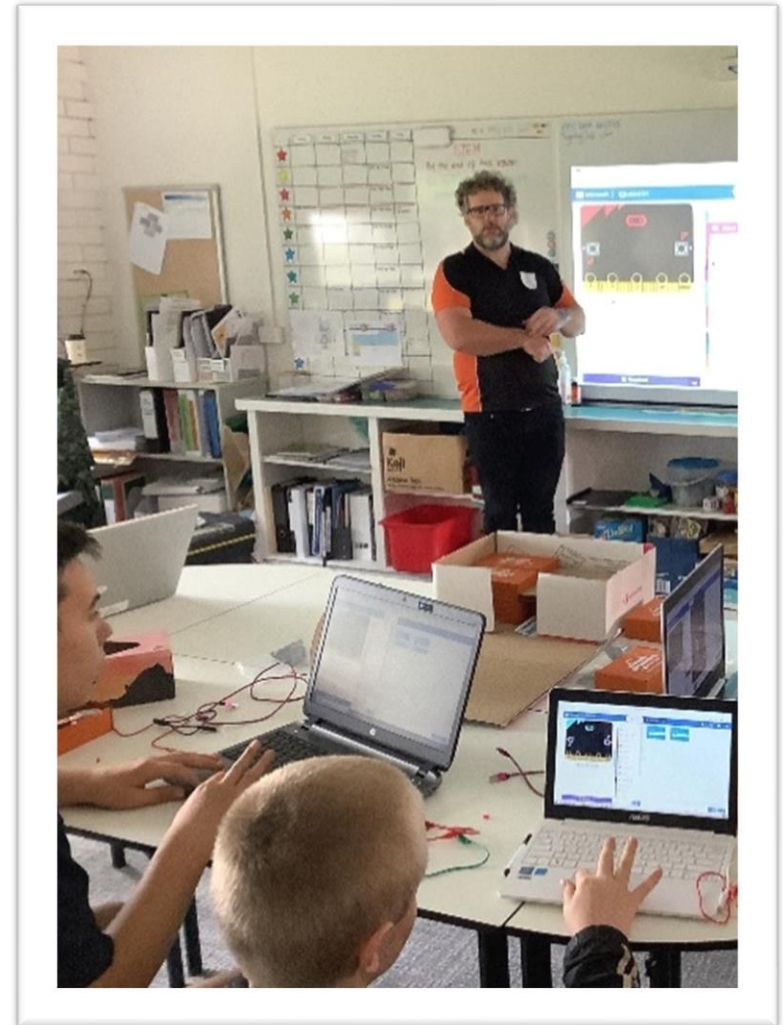
Balcatta senior High School has embraced the use of technology to support the development of **21st Century Skills** and student achievement of the **West Australian Curriculum's General Capabilities**

- In 2021, BSHS introduced the POD program where all Year 7 students commenced High School with a personal device for use across all learning areas. We are now in our fourth year and have coverage across Years 7-10.
- Access to a personal device enables students to interact with learning materials in an interactive learning environment. Teachers can integrate technology into lesson delivery and provide timely feedback to their class
- PODs will be required to meet the school's defined specifications and students will be required to adhere to responsibilities for appropriate use of ICT in schools.

Minimum Requirements

Parents may choose to purchase a device from any source, however, only devices with the minimum requirements mentioned below will be able to be used in the school. For devices purchased elsewhere, [download Office 365](#), free of charge.

Students are expected to have a device that meets the following minimal requirements:

- Windows 11
- WiFi
- Keyboard
- Touch screen and **stylus (essential for Mathematics)**
- In-built camera and microphone
- Headphone connection
- Long battery life – to be charged at home
- Small and robust
- Fits in normal school bag (not separate from)
- Takes up minimal space on the student's desk

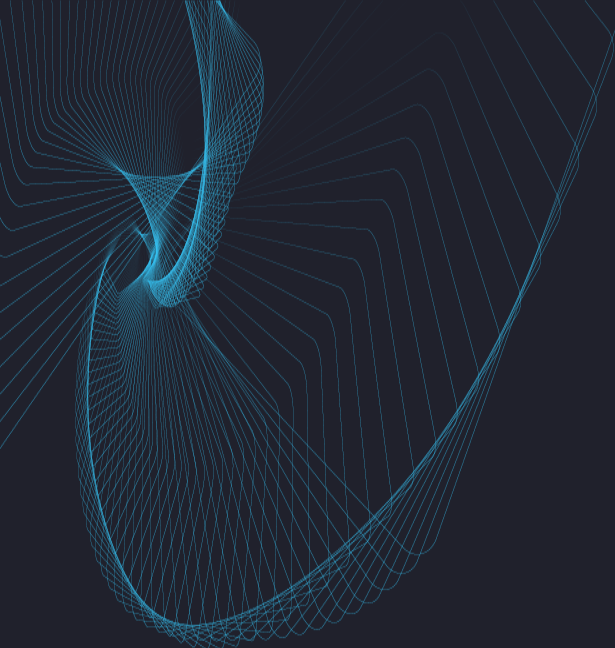
